## RESOLUTION NO. 249

A RESOLUTION OF APPLICATION BY SUNNYSLOPE COUNTY WATER DISTRICT REQUESTING THE LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION TO TAKE PRELIMINARY PROCEEDINGS FOR ANNEXATION OF TERRITORY TO THE DISTRICT

## SUNNYSLOPE COUNTY WATER DISTRICT ANNEXATION NO. 79-3

RESOLVED, by the Board of Directors of the Sunnyslope County Water District, San Benito County, California, that

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the District desires to initiate preliminary proceedings pursuant to the District Reorganization Act of 1965, Title 6, Division 1 of the Government Code of the State of California, comprising Sections 56000 through 56550 of said Code, for the annexation of certain territory more particularly described in Exhibit "A", hereto attached and by reference incorporated herein, to said District (hereinafter sometimes referred to as the "Territory");

WHEREAS, the proposed annexation of the Territory to Sunnyslope County Water District will affect the County of San Benito, State of California, and the City of Hollister;

WHEREAS, the Territory proposed to be annexed is uninhabited, as such term is defined in Section 56074 of the Government Code, a part of the District Reorganization Act of 1965, and a description of the exterior boundaries of the Territory is set forth in said Exhibit "A";

WHEREAS, it is desired to provide that the proposed annexation be subject to certain terms and conditions, as follows:

 In the event that pursuant to rules, regulations or ordinances of the District, as now or hereafter amended, the District shall require any payment of a fixed or determinable amount of money, either as a lump sum or in installments, for the acquisition, transfer, use or right of use of all or any part of the existing property, real or personal, of the District, such payment will be made to the District in the manner and at the time as provided by the rules, regulations, or ordinances of the District, as now or hereinafter amended.

2. Upon and after the effective date of said annexation, the Territory, all inhabitants within such Territory, and all persons entitled to vote by reason of residing or owning land within the Territory, shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the District; shall have the same rights and duties as if the Territory had been a part of the District upon its original formation; shall be liable for the payment of principal, interest, and any other amounts which shall become due on account of any outstanding or then authorized but thereafter issued bonds, including revenue bonds, or other contracts or obligations of the District; shall be subject to the levying or fixing and collection of any and all taxes, assessments, service charges, rentals or rates as may be necessary to provide for such payment; and shall be subject to all of the rates, rules, regulations and ordinances of the District, as now or hereafter amended; and

WHEREAS, all of the owners of land within the Territory proposed to be annexed have signed a written consent to the annexation of said Territory to Sunnyslope County Water District;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY FOUND, DETERMINED and ORDERED, as follows:

1. That this resolution of application be, and it is hereby, adopted and approved by the Board of Directors of the Sunnyslope County Water District, and the Local Agency Formation Commission of San Benito County be, and it is hereby, requested to undertake

preliminary proceedings for the annexation of the Territory described in Exhibit "A" hereto attached and by reference incorporated herein to Sunnyslope County Water District on the terms and conditions above stated and in the manner provided by the District Reorganization Act of 1965.

- 2. That the Territory proposed to be annexed to Sunnyslope County Water District is uninhabited. The exterior boundaries of the Territory proposed to be annexed are more particularly described in said Exhibit "A".
- 3. That the reasons for this proposed change of organization are as follows:
  - (a) Sunnyslope County Water District is authorized and empowered to, and is presently engaged in, the furnishing and distribution of water, and has a system and works for the providing of water facilities, which system can adequately and economically furnish services which are urgently needed within the Territory proposed to be annexed.
  - (b) There is no other Governmental agency which is presently able to furnish water services and there is no immediate prospect that any other agency will be able to furnish such services within the reasonably foreseeable future.
- 4. That the Local Agency Formation Commission is hereby requested to approve the proposed annexation without notice and hearing by the Commission, and to transmit its approval to and authorize the Board of Directors of the District to annex the Territory to the District without notice and hearing by the Board of Directors of the District and without an election, in accordance

with the authorizations and requirements of said District Reorganization Act.

- 5. That all of the owners of lands within the Territory proposed to be annexed have filed a written consent to the annexation of said Territory without notice or hearing, and the Board of Directors of the Sunnyslope County Water District hereby waives the right to mailed notice of hearing pursuant to authorization contained in Section 56261 of the Government Code, unless the Local Agency Formation Commission intends to impose conditions on said proposed annexation other than those stated herein.
- 6. That the Secretary of the District be, and he is hereby, authorized and directed to file a certified copy of this resolution with the Executive Officer of the Local Agency Formation Commission of the County of San Benito, State of California, and to attach thereto a copy of the written consent to such annexation of all of the owners of all of the lands within the Territory proposed to be annexed to the District.

## EXHIBIT A

That part of Homestead Lot 44 and 45 of the San Justo Rancho, according to the Map thereof filed July 21, 1876 in Volume 1 of Maps at page 64, San Benito County Records, bounded and particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point in the Easterly line of the San Justo Rancho distant thereon South 2°13' West 984.47 feet from an iron pipe and 2" x 3" witness stake at the easterly common corner to Lots 37 and 44 as shown on said Map, said point of beginning being also an angle point in the Sunnyslope County Water District boundary; thence along the District boundary and along the Easterly line of the San Justo Rancho and said Lot 44, South 2° 13' West 2349.98 feet to the corner common to Lots 44 and 45; thence continuing along the District boundary the Easterly line of the San Justo Rancho, and the Easterly line of Lot 45 South 2°13' West 311.72 feet to an iron pipe in the Northerly line of the State Highway to Tres Pinos; thence leaving said Sunnyslope County Water District Boundary and running along said Highway Line, North 54°18' West 2682.63 feet to an iron pipe in the line common to Lots 43 and 44 (at 316.09 feet is a 2" x 3" stake in the line common to Lots 44 and 45) being also a point on said Water District boundary thence along said boundary and line common to Lots 43 and 44 North 1°15' East 1215.92 feet to an iron pope and 2" x 3" witness stake from which the Northwesterly corner the Northerly line of Lot 44, and District boundary South 86°55' East 2258.54 feet to the point of beginning, containing 100.00 acres, more or less.
