## RESOLUTION NO. 133

A RESOLUTION MAKING DETERMINATION ON ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT, DETERMINING CATEGORICAL EXEMPTION, APPROVING PLANS FOR MODIFICATIONS TO RIDGEMARK WELL AND ESTABLISHING PREVAILING WAGE SCALE

## SUNNYSLOPE COUNTY WATER DISTRICT

RESOLVED, by the Board of Directors of the Sunnyslope County Water District, San Benito County, California, that

- 1. The modification of the Ridgemark well in accordance with the plans approved herein is consistent with the State and Local Guidelines adopted pursuant to the Environmental Quality Act and that the impact on the proposed well site improvement will not be substantial and that the Board does hereby find and determine that in this particular instance there will not be a significant effect on the environment from the proposed improvements.
- 2. Those certain plans for modification of the Ridgemark well, prepared by Daniel J. Weatherly, District Engineer, and filed with the Secretary of said District this date be, and the same are hereby, approved and adopted.
- 3. The notice inviting sealed proposals for the modification of the Ridgemark well heretofore given, be, and it is hereby, ratified and approved.
- 4. Pursuant to said notice a sealed proposal or bid has been publicly opened, examined and declared on this date for the modifications of the Ridgemark well, in accordance with the plans.
- 5. Payments for said work to be done by the contractor shall be made in cash by said District to the contractor on itemized estimates duly certified and approved by the District Engineer and the Board of Directors, based on labor and materials performed and furnished by the contractor, and incorporated into said work during the preceding month, but said District shall retain 10% of the amount of each of such estimates, and the

accumulation of said amounts so retained from said progressive payments will be paid to said contractor thirty-five (35) days after the completion and acceptance of said work by said District Engineer and the Board of Directors.

- 6. Said bidder shall within ten (10) days after written notice that the contract has been awarded to him, enter into a contract with the District, the faithful performance of which shall be secured by an undertaking in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the amount so bid, with sureties satisfactory to the Board of Directors, and which shall be accompanied by a labor and material bond in a sum equal to fifty percent (50%) of the amount of said bid, under the provisions of Title 1, Division 5, Chapter 3 of the Government Code of the State of California.
- 7. That the wage scale for the modification of the Ridgemark well shall be, and it is hereby, determined to be the general prevailing wage scale adopted by the Board of Supervisors of San Benito County currently in effect and on file in the office of the Board of Supervisors and incorporated herein by reference. Not less than said prevailing rate of per diem wages shall be paid for any work proposed to be performed in accordance with said plans.
