

RESOLUTION NO. 276

A RESOLUTION MAKING A NEGATIVE DETERMINATION
ON ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT, DETERMINING NEGATIVE
DECLARATION AND PROVIDING FOR NOTICE THEREOF

AIRLINE HIGHWAY WATER MAIN EXTENSION

SUNNYSLOPE COUNTY WATER DISTRICT

RESOLVED, by the Board of Directors of the Sunnyslope County
Water District, San Benito County, California, that

WHEREAS, a Preliminary Environmental Assessment has been
prepared by the District Engineer and filed with the District
Secretary, which recommends that the project be treated as a
negative declaration inasmuch as it will have no significant effect
on the environment pursuant to the District's Local Environmental
Guidelines and the State Guidelines;

WHEREAS, the project concerning which this determination is
made is described, as follows:

Eight (8) inch and twelve (12) inch water main
extending from a new well on Enterprise Road, along
Enterprise Road to the east end of the old "Caldera Pit" then
across the gravel pit to and across Airline Highway, thence
along the northeast side of Airline Highway to and along
Valley View Road to connect into the existing mains at
Crestview Road. The project is part of an ongoing project to
provide supplementation to the water supply system of the
District which will constitute one as to which a negative
declaration may be issued based on an initial study
heretofore prepared and filed with the District.

WHEREAS, this Board, on February 26, 1981, adopted its
Resolution Approving an Initial Study, an Environmental Impact
Assessment and a Proposed Negative Declaration and Providing for
Notice Thereof, pursuant to which Notice of the Proposed Negative
Declaration was given; and

WHEREAS, this Board has heard and considered the evidence and
facts presented relating to the nature of the proposed project and
the Proposed Negative Declaration;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY FOUND, DECLARED and ORDERED, as follows:

1. That it is hereby found that said Project will not have a significant effect upon the environment and is entitled to be determined to be subject to a negative determination on environmental impact and, consequently, to a negative declaration.

2. That the Secretary be, and he is hereby, authorized and instructed to file certified copies of this Resolution and a Notice of Determination with a copy of the Environmental Impact Assessment attached at the District office to be available for public inspection and copying and in the office of the County Clerk of San Benito County.




Finding: It is hereby found that the above-named project will not have a significant effect upon the environment.
