

RESOLUTION NO. 348

A RESOLUTION MAKING A NEGATIVE DETERMINATION
ON ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT, DETERMINING NEGATIVE
DECLARATION AND PROVIDING FOR NOTICE THEREOF

GRAVEL ENVELOPE WELL NO. 7

SUNNYSLOPE COUNTY WATER DISTRICT

RESOLVED, by the Board of Directors of the Sunnyslope County Water District, San Benito County, California, that

WHEREAS, a Preliminary Environmental Assessment has been prepared by the District Engineer and filed with the District Secretary, which recommends that the project be treated as a negative declaration inasmuch as it will have no significant effect on the environment pursuant to the District's Local Environmental Guidelines and the State Guidelines;

WHEREAS, the project concerning which this determination is made is described, as follows:

The drilling of a test well and well and the installation of all appurtenances thereto in accordance with the plans and specifications.

WHEREAS, this Board, on December 6, 1984, adopted its Resolution Ratifying and Approving an Environmental Impact Assessment and a Proposed Negative Declaration and the Giving of Notice Thereof, pursuant to which Notice of the Proposed Negative Declaration was given; and

WHEREAS, this Board has heard and considered the evidence and facts presented relating to the nature of the proposed project and the Proposed Negative Declaration;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY FOUND, DECLARED and ORDERED, as follows:

1. That it is hereby found that said Project will not have a significant effect upon the environment for the following reasons, and is entitled to be determined to be subject to a negative determination on environmental impact and, consequently, to a negative declaration;

- a. Because the nature of the proposed use will not have any significant effect on the environment and the withdrawal of water from the groundwater basin will be substantially replenished either through irrigation or land disposal of sewage effluent and will not require any mitigation measures.
- b. There is no known public controversy concerning any environmental effects of the proposed use.

2. That the Secretary be, and he is hereby, authorized and instructed to file certified copies of this Resolution and a Notice of Determination, with a copy of the Initial Study and the Environmental Impact Assessment attached, at the District office to be available for public inspection and copying and in the office of the County Clerk of San Benito County.


