

ORDINANCE NO. 29

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 4 ENTITLED
"AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING RATES, RULES AND
REGULATIONS FOR WATER SERVICE BY THE SUNNYSLOPE
COUNTY WATER DISTRICT"

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Board of Directors of the Sunnyslope
County Water District, San Benito County, California, as follows:

Section 1. Section 302 of Article 19 of Ordinance No. 4,
entitled "An Ordinance Establishing Rates, Rules and Regulations for
Water Service by the Sunnyslope County Water District," passed and
adopted September 8, 1955, as amended, is hereby amended by amending
Section 302 thereof, to read as follows:

"302. Connection Charge - Rights of Service in
Existing Facilities. A connection charge for the right of
service in existing and proposed and pending water supply,
storage, transmission, and distribution facilities of the
District shall be payable to District for all water
connections within the boundary of District. The charge
shall be Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00) per family unit."

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect October 1, 1979.


Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances

inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.



DETERMINATIONS OF EXEMPTION PURSUANT
TO CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT

WATER CONNECTION AND SEWER SERVICE CHARGES

SUNNYSLOPE COUNTY WATER DISTRICT

RESOLVED, by the Board of Directors of the Sunnyslope County Water District, San Benito County, as follows:

WHEREAS, King and Domingues Accountancy Corporation, Certified Public Accountants, has made and filed written recommendations on District's operations indicating deficits in certain accounts due to the current rate structure of the District, and the District's Engineer has made recommendations with reference to revisions in the District's water connection and sewer service charges;

WHEREAS, the public interest, convenience and necessity will be served thereby;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY FOUND and DETERMINED that

1. The revisions proposed in the Sunnyslope County Water District's water connection and sewer service charges pursuant to said recommendations submitted by the Accountants and the District Engineer at the meeting of September 13, 1979, are exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to Section 21080 of the Public Resources Code of the State of California and especially subsection (b) (8) thereof which provides that the establishment, modification, structuring, restructuring, or approval of rates, tolls, fares or other charges by public agencies which the public agency finds are for the purpose of meeting operating expenses, purchasing or leasing supplies, meeting financial reserve needs and requirements or obtaining funds for capital projects, necessary to maintain services within existing service areas may be exempt.

2. The proposed revisions in the charges, in accordance with the recommendations contained in said Accountants' and Engineer's report shall be, and they are hereby, found to be necessary to permit the District to raise funds for the purposes stated in Section 1 hereof. It is hereby specifically found that without the revisions proposed in said Engineer's report, the District will be unable to meet the expenses in order to maintain existing levels of service within existing service areas.

3. That the Secretary be, and he is hereby, authorized and instructed, to make copies of this Resolution available for public inspection in the District office.

DETERMINATIONS OF EXEMPTION PURSUANT
TO CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT

WATER CHARGES

SUNNYSLOPE COUNTY WATER DISTRICT

RESOLVED, by the Board of Directors of the Sunnyslope County Water District, San Benito County, as follows:

WHEREAS, King and Domingues Accountancy Corporation, Certified Public Accountants, has made and filed written recommendations on District's operations indicating deficits in certain accounts due to the current rate structure of the District, and the District's Engineer has made recommendations with reference to revisions in the District's water charges and has filed a written rate study based on said financial report;

WHEREAS, the public interest, convenience and necessity will be served thereby;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY FOUND and DETERMINED that

1. The revisions proposed in the Sunnyslope County Water District's water charges pursuant to said recommendations submitted by the Accountants and the report of the District Engineer are exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to Section 21080 of the Public Resources Code of the State of California and especially subsection (b) (8) thereof which provides that the establishment, modification, structuring, restructuring, or approval of rates, tolls, fares or other charges by public agencies which the public agency finds are for the purpose of meeting operating expenses, purchasing or leasing supplies, meeting financial reserve needs and requirements or obtaining funds for capital projects, necessary to maintain services within existing service areas may be exempt.

2. The proposed revisions in the charges, in accordance with the recommendations contained in said Accountants' and Engineer's report shall be, and they are hereby, found to be necessary to permit the District to raise funds for the purposes stated in Section 1 hereof. It is hereby specifically found that without the revisions proposed in said Engineer's report, the District will be unable to meet the expenses in order to maintain existing levels of service within existing service areas.

3. That the Secretary be, and he is hereby, authorized and instructed, to make copies of this Resolution available for public inspection in the District office.
