

RESOLUTION NO. 199

A RESOLUTION CALLING AND PROVIDING
FOR 1977 GENERAL DISTRICT ELECTION

SUNNYSLOPE COUNTY WATER DISTRICT

RESOLVED, by the Board of Directors of the Sunnyslope County Water District, San Benito County, California, that

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Uniform District Election Law, commencing with Section 23500 of the Elections Code of the State of California, a General District Election will be held in this District on Tuesday, November 8, 1977, the same being the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November of an odd numbered year, for the election of three (3) Directors;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED and ORDERED as follows:

1. That said General District Election shall be held, as provided by law, in said District on Tuesday, the 8th day of November, 1977.
2. That, pursuant to Section 23511 of the Elections Code, said County Clerk is hereby requested to publish a Notice of Election once in a newspaper of general circulation published in the District, or, if no such newspaper is published in the District, in a newspaper having general circulation in the District published in the County. Such publication shall be had at least 75 days, and not more than 100 days, before the day fixed for the election.
3. That upon receipt of a copy of the published Notice from said County Clerk, pursuant to Section 23521, the Secretary is directed to post said Notice in the District office.
4. Blank forms of "Official Filing Petition" for use at said election shall be obtained from either the District Secretary's office or the office of said County Clerk, commencing on August 11, 1977, being the 89th day prior to the election.

5. Nomination petitions shall be filed with the County Clerk, either by certified mail or during regular office hours but not later than Friday, September 2, 1977, at 5:00 o'clock p.m. The District Secretary is directed to request the County Clerk to provide him with a copy of each duly filed nomination petition.

6. The establishment of election precincts, defining their boundaries, selection of polling places and appointment of the respective election officers, will be determined by the County Clerk as provided by law.

7. The County shall be reimbursed all actual costs incurred by the County Clerk thereof in conducting the General District Election.

8. Each candidate for elective office may prepare a Statement of Qualifications pursuant to Section 10012 of the Elections Code, of no more than 200 words. Such Statement shall be filed in the office of the County Clerk when the candidate's nomination papers are returned for filing. The prorated costs of printing and handling each candidate's Statement of Qualifications shall be paid by that candidate, including the costs of translating and printing said Statement in Spanish, if any candidate requests a Spanish translation.

9. At the first regular or special meeting after the County Clerk has declared the elected candidates, this Board of Directors shall confirm such declaration of the elected candidates. Thereafter, the County Clerk shall make, sign, seal and deliver to each person elected, and who shall have complied with Section 23559 of the Elections Code, a Certificate of Election.
