

RESOLUTION NO. 6

CANVASSING RETURNS AND DECLARING RESULT
OF BOND ELECTION HELD MAY 3, 1955.

RESOLVED, by the Board of Directors of the Sunnyslope County Water District, San Benito County, California, that

WHEREAS, said Board by Resolution No. 5 adopted on the 25th day of March, 1955, duly called and ordered held in said District a special bond election on the 3rd day of May, 1955, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors thereof the proposition therein set forth;

WHEREAS, said special bond election was held and conducted on said day, as required by law and said resolution;

WHEREAS, it appears that notice of said election was duly and legally given, that the voting precinct was properly established therefor, that polling place cards and sample ballots were mailed to all registered voters in the District, election officers were appointed and election supplies furnished; and that in all respects said election was held and conducted and the votes cast thereat received and canvassed, and the returns thereof made, determined and declared in time, form and manner as required by law;

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of said District met at the regular meeting place of said Board on May 9, 1955, to canvass the returns of said election and declare the result thereof;

WHEREAS, said canvass was duly completed and the results thereof are as hereinafter set forth;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY FOUND, DETERMINED and RESOLVED, as follows:

1. That said special bond election was held and conducted in the Sunnyslope County Water District, County of San Benito, State of California, on Tuesday, May 3, 1955, in the time, form and manner as required by law.

2. That there was one voting precinct established in said District for the purpose of holding said election, which consisted of such portions of Enterprise Precinct No. 1 as last established by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Benito insofar as it falls wholly or partially within the Sunnyslope County Water District and which was designated and located as follows:

3. That a canvass of the votes cast in said District upon the measure thereat submitted was duly held in accordance with the order of the Board of Directors and in accordance with law.

4. That the proposition voted upon in said special bond election and the number of votes received for and against the proposition in the precinct established therefor are as follows:

PROPOSITION: "Shall the Sunnyslope County Water District incur a bonded indebtedness in the amount of One Hundred and Ten Thousand Dollars (\$110,000.00) for construction, purchase or otherwise acquiring of water supply, storage and transmission facilities, mains and appurtenances, and lands and easements necessary therefor, and work and improvements auxiliary thereto necessary to complete same, for the benefit of said District and of its inhabitants?"

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5. That _____ duly registered voters, who expected to be absent from their respective election precincts on the day of the election secured ballots from the Secretary of said District.

6. That the Secretary has certified to this Board that _____ of said absentee ballots issued by him have been cast within the time required by law.

7. That the Board of Directors canvassed said absentee ballots and counted the same personally, whereupon it was found that the result of the ballots cast by said absentee voters, without regard to the precinct within which the voters are registered, were _____ votes for and _____ against said proposition.

8. That the total number of votes cast in said District for and against the proposition is as follows:

9. That at said election, more than two-thirds of the votes cast thereat were in favor of and authorized the issuing of said bonds in the amount and for the purpose set forth in said proposition herein stated; that said proposition has been accepted and approved by the electors of said District, and that said bonds will be issued to defray the costs of the improvement heretofore specified and to the amount stated therein.

10. That the Secretary of this Board be, and he is hereby, instructed to enter this resolution in full, in the minutes of this Board as a statement of the result of said Special District Bond Election.
